Project Abstract

The city of Norfolk experienced its first Light Rail System aka "The Tide", which is a 7.4 mile light rail system traveling from downtown Norfolk to Newtown Road. In the planning of The Tide, it was determined that 1.57 acres of wetlands would be disturbed and as a result a 1.8 acre wetland mitigation project was established. Team Henry was proud to contribute to the project by performing the erosion control, grading, riparian seeding, wetland planting, goose exclusion fence and evasive species control.

The project was one of difficulty working right along the Elizabeth River and dealing with two daily high tides. The willingness of Team Henry to work abnormal work hours and providing experienced personnel with a "can do" attitude the project was completed ahead of schedule and under budget.
