Project Abstract

At the time, Telegraph Road Interchange was the largest project awarded in the history of The Virginia Department of Transportation, over 236 million. The project was a continuation of the Woodrow Wilson Bridge project and deemed a highly visible mega project. Because of the proximity of the Cameron Run stream to the Telegraph Road Interchange, an area of huge importance and scrutiny was the erosion control.

On this large and challenging five year project, Team Henry was responsible for controlling erosion, sediment runoff and maintaining the integrity of the E&S controls during the entire 5 year project, Team Henry was more than willing to accept the challenge. Among other erosion and sediment control items such as check dams, culvert and inlet protection, the project required over 75,000 linear feet of super silt fence.
